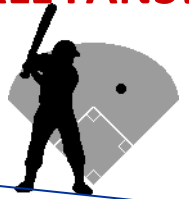

June 27th Architectural River Cruise: \$29 (Lincoln Park Zoo is free admission)

\$244 per person, double occupancy

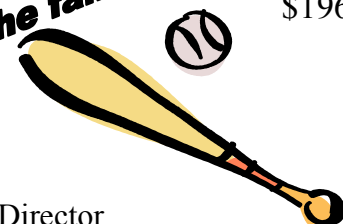
