## Thursday, July 29

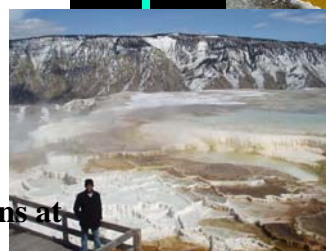
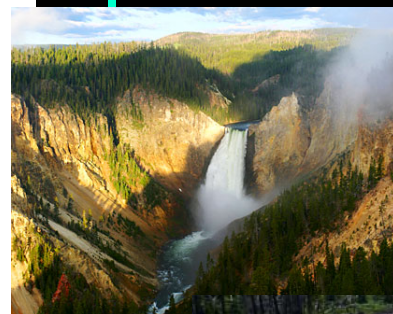
Travelers can explore the Buffalo Bill Historical Center and then journey to Yellowstone Park.
