REGISTRATION AND FEES

- Registration opens March 1st
- All participants must pay a one-time \$35 Supplies Fee.
- Please register by the Monday prior of each week to avoid a \$10 late fee.
- A child's spot in camp will only be held for the days which are paid or scheduled for payment.

GENERAL INFORMATION

CAMP READY KIDS!

Camp does not serve breakfast, please make sure your child eats breakfast before attending each day. Please also send a spare set of clothes marked with your child's name each day or you may leave a spare set at the center.

Little Campers: Please provide a crib size sheet and blanket for nap/quiet time. Campers will have the chance to bring items from home one time each month and share with friends. A sharing bucket will be sent home to return with items to share the next day.

Summer Day Campers: Please wear closed-toed shoes at all times for camp. No flip-flops allowed. Please bring camp t-shirt on field trip days. **The Summer Camp has a zero screen time policy. Please keep cell phones home.**

MEALS AND SNACKS

Lunches will be provided through The Marshalltown Summer Food Service Program. A lunch menu will be sent home and posted. This free program ends in August, exact date TBD. At which time, campers will need to pack a lunch to bring daily. Healthy snacks will be provided in the morning and afternoon.

COMMUNICATION

- Parents or approved adults must sign campers in and out each day.
- A monthly lunch menu will be posted.

REQUIREMENTS

Little Campers is offered to children 3- 6 years of age. Children must be fully potty-trained and 3 years old by June 1st to register. Any children 5-6 years of age and entering Kindergarten in the Fall will also be placed in this camp. Children entering 1st grade in the Fall -6th grade will be registered for Y Day Camp. An enrollment packet will be given at initial registration and must be filled out completely in order to attend.

HOURS

Camp will run June 10- August 16. Camp hours are Monday-Friday, 7:15 a.m-5:30 p.m. Little Campers will be closed August 19-23 for Maintenance Cleaning. Y Preschool 2019-2020 begins August 26. Camp is held in Y Preschool Classrooms.
